Getting Here

Premier is located at **Brainard Airport**, off Maxim Road, on Lindbergh Drive.

From the North - Route 91 South to exit 27. Left off exit. At next light turn left. After next stoplight turn right onto Lindbergh Drive. Premier is the fourth building on the left.

From the South - Route 91 North to exit 27. Left off exit. After second stoplight turn right onto Lindbergh Drive. Premier is the fourth building on the left.

From the Northeast – Route 84 West to left exit marked Route 5, 15, & 91 South. Take exit 87 labeled Brainard Airport exit. Left at stoplight. After second stoplight turn right onto Lindbergh Drive. Premier is the fourth building on the left.

From the Southeast – Route 2 West to Route 3 North. Take 91 North to exit 27. Left at stoplight. After second stoplight turn right onto Lindbergh Drive. Premier is the fourth building on the left.

From the West – Route 84 East to Route 91 South to exit 27. Left off exit. At next light turn left. After next stoplight turn right onto Lindbergh Drive. Premier is the fourth building on the left.
